- Your age on January 1st generally determines the age class that you ride in for the entire season. You may choose to move up to a higher age if you are that age, but if done during mid-season, any existing points you've earned will not be transferred to that new class.
- If you just want to ride the event to help your kid or family member, you can ride "P" class. "P" class riders are not scored and are not eligible for trophies or series points.
- If you just want to ride the event for fun and not be scored for a trophy, you can ride "X" class. "X" class riders also do not earn series points.
- Classes A, B, and C will ride only the first loop for this event. All other classes will run the full course. A, B, and C classes will start in later rows to help minimize traffic and passing on the trail.
- Parents and support riders should ride BEHIND their child. It's easier to keep an eye on them, and helps riders develop a better understanding of timekeeping and strategy if they to do it on their own as much as possible.
- The intent and spirit of the Family Enduro Series is to help teach the sport of enduros and timekeeping. Enduro computers <u>are not allowed</u>, only an odometer and clock/watch.
- The best 5 out of 8 events will count towards overall standings and awards at the end-of-season banquet.
- Please do not use an FES event to "race" as a way of practicing for the adult enduro held on Sunday. If you ride the AMA enduro series, you should NOT be competing for points in the FES.
